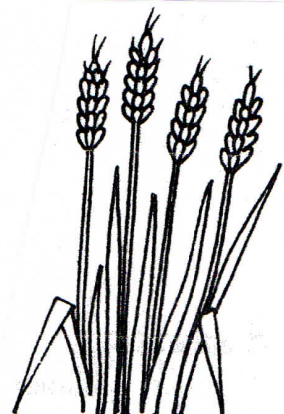
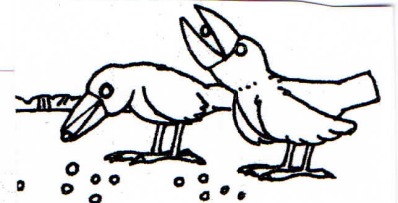

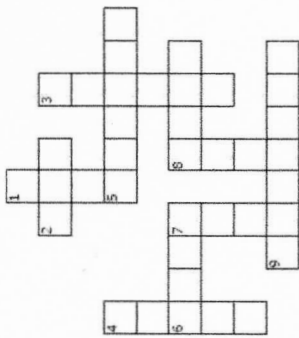

Crossword Puzzle



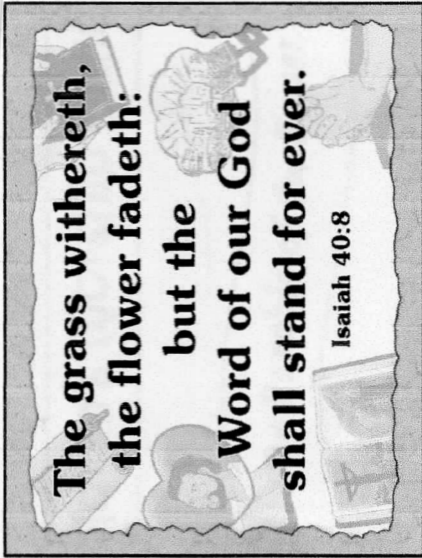
