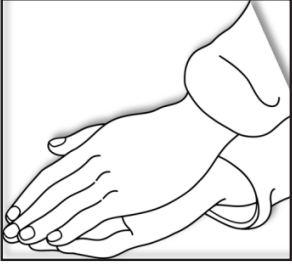
### THE WICKED HUSBANDMAN/THE UNFORGIVING SERVANT

## Matthew 18
